1. School Uniforms are available to purchase. KMG now has school shorts which form part of the uniform. As part of your school levy, you do get a school shirt and a pair of shorts. Parent/Carer just need to pay the first term at the minimum to receive the uniform pack. Uniform days are still Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. **If you have financial difficulty, please see Helen or Dayna.**
2. The student transport assistance program will commence when safe to do so. Please be advised, that you will need to complete an application and have it returned. The ESD will process the applications asap to ensure that all students requiring transport assistance are catered to. **Please see Helen or Dayna for an application.**
3. Student School Photos will happen on Monday 7th February. Please ensure you are in your school uniform. School ID cards will then be distributed on Wednesday 9th February. *If you are not present on the 7th of February, you will not get the opportunity to have a school ID.* **Please see Helen or Dayna if you know you will be absent.**

COVID19 NEWS

The Premier has announced several changes that will affect the 2022 school year. These are:

- Delaying the commencement of the school year by two weeks for most students. Onsite learning for the school year will now commence on 7 February. All year levels will return on this date.
- For Year 11 and 12 students, remote learning, will commence from Monday the 31st of January. During this period, all other students will still be on holiday and not provided remote learning.

At KMG all students, staff, parents, carers, and visitors will be collecting specific information to ensure fast and efficient contact tracing in the event of a COVID19 positive case at KMG. This will be

done via KMG's Check in QLD app. A manual sign-in sheet will be made available for you if you do not have access to a mobile phone or electronic device.
